Relationship between Renaissance period and medieval drama

Firstly, Renaissance which means rebirth in French, the European civilization immediately following the medieval period also known as the middle age and conventionally held to have been characterized by a surge of interest in classical scholarship and values. The term middle age was coined by scholars in the 15th century to designate the interval between the downfall of the Greece and Rome.
