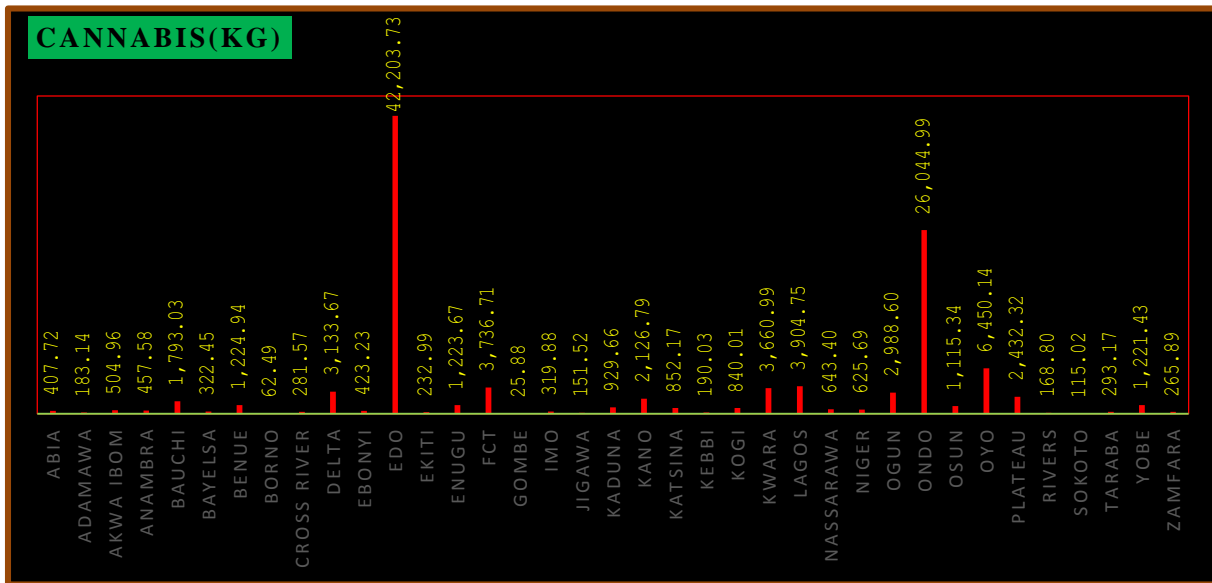


DRUG SEIZED (CANNABIS(Kg)) BY GEOPOLITICAL ZONES IN NIGERIA, 2018.

This chart shows the amount of cannabis seized in 2018, across the six geopolitical zones in Nigeria.

North East: Bauchi (1,793.03kg), Yobe (1,221.43kg) recorded highest while Borno (62.49kg) and Gombe (25.88kg) recorded least amount of cannabis seized.

North West: Kano State (2,126.79kg) recorded highest while Sokoto (115.02kg) and Kebbi (190.03kg) state recorded least amount of cannabis seized.

North Central: FCT (3,736.71kg), Kwara (3,660.99kg), followed by Plateau state (2,432.32kg) recorded highest. similarly Niger state (625.69kg) recorded least amount of cannabis seized.

South West: Ondo (26,044.99kg), Oyo (6,450.14kg) followed by Lagos (3,904.75kg) while Ekiti State (232.99kg) recorded the least amount of cannabis seized.

South South: Edo state significantly recorded 42,203.73kg, followed by Delta (3,133.67kg), similarly Rivers state had least record of cannabis seized

South East: Enugu state (1,223.67kg) tops the list with a total amount of cannabis seized and Imo state (319.88kg) recorded the least amount of cannabis seized.

However, among the six geopolitical zones, South South significantly tops the list with a total amount of 46,615.18kg, followed by South West with a total amount of 37,748.21kg, whilst South East recorded the least amount of cannabis seized with total of 2,832.08kg.
