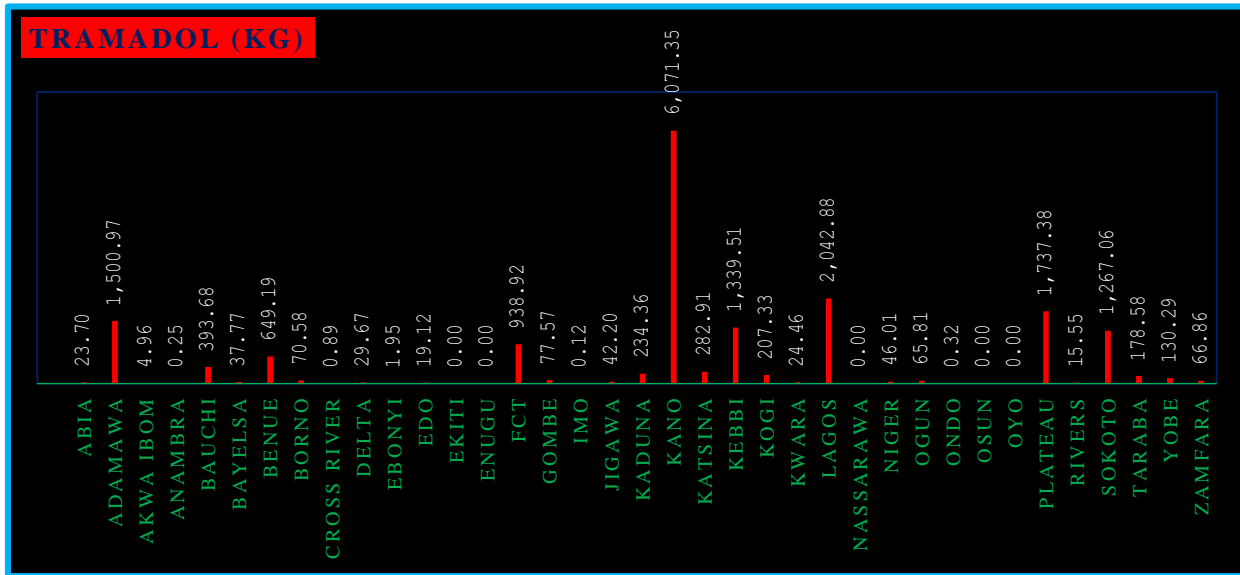


**DRUG SEIZED (TRAMADOL(Kg)) BY GEOPOLITICAL ZONES IN NIGERIA, 2018.**

This chart shows the amount of tramadol seized in 2018, across the six geopolitical zones in Nigeria.

North East: Adamawa State (1,500.57kg) recorded highest while Borno State (70.58kg) recorded least amount of tramadol seized.

North West: Kano State (6,071.35kg) recorded highest while Jigawa State (42.20kg) recorded least amount of tramadol seized.

North Central: Plateau state (2,432.32kg) recorded highest while Nasarawa state (0kg) had no record least of tramadol seized.

South West: Lagos State (2,042.88kg) while Ekiti, Oyo and Osun State (0kg) had no record of tramadol seized.

South South: Bayelsa state recorded 37.77kg, also Cross Rivers state had least record of tramadol seized, with total amount of 0.89kg.

South East: Abia state (23.70kg) tops the list of total amount of tramadol seized and Enugu state (0kg) had no record of tramadol seized.

However, among the six geopolitical zones, the total amount of tramadol seized in North West (9,237.39kg) is higher than the total amount of drugs seized in South East (26.02kg), South South (107.96kg), South West (2109.01kg), North East (2,351.27kg) and North Central (2,954.1kg).
